CHURCH REVITALIZATION EXPERT TO PREACH SEPTEMBER 10

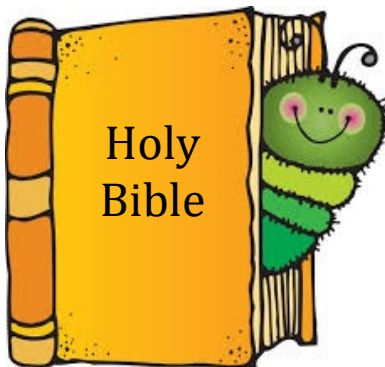
